Chapter 18

Paul leaves Athens and extends the mission to Corinth and Ephesus.

Read Acts 18:1-18

1. What is happening to the Jews living in Rome at this time?
2. Paul “lived and worked” with Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18:3). What impact do you think Paul had on Aquila and Priscilla—Jews from Rome—during this period? Note what Aquila and Priscilla do later in this chapter.
3. What do we learn about Paul’s occupation (what he did while not evangelizing)? Why do you suppose he did this work?
4. While in Corinth, what did Paul do on the Sabbath? How does this mirror what he did in other cities?

Read Acts 18:19-28

Paul leaves Corinth. He takes Aquila and Priscilla with him.

1. Who is Apollos (Acts 18:24-28)?
2. How did Aquila and Priscilla respond to him (Acts 18:26)?
3. What affect did Aquila and Priscilla have on Apollos (Acts 18:27-28)?

LIFE APPLICATION

1. Reflect on the role of Priscilla in this passage. How is she a role model for women believers?
2. How does evangelism during Paul's time differ from evangelism today? List some differences.
3. It seems that Paul had a strategy for evangelism. Should we have a strategy too?
4. How does Acts 18 challenge you to more effectively proclaim the Gospel?
